Cycle from Bristol to Paris and enjoy a once-in-a-lifetime adventure whilst raising money for the Hospice.

Last year, a team of **50 cyclists** raised over **£170,000** for patient care, meaning that we can continue to be there for patients when they need us most, in their own homes and on our Inpatient Unit.

What to expect



Ben, from our Fundraising Team, took part in 2024 and shares his experience:

Day
1

Bristol to Warminster: We kicked off just after lunch with a quick briefing then hopped on our bikes. The ride took us through Bath and the Cotswolds. After 40 miles, we arrived in Warminster for dinner.

Day
2

Warminster to Portsmouth: We cycled 67 miles through beautiful countryside and stopped in Salisbury, then cruised down to Portsmouth, where we had dinner and boarded the ferry to Caen, France.

Day
3

Caen to Evreux: We arrived ahead of schedule, enjoyed breakfast in Caen and got cycling again, on the opposite side of the road! After 88 miles, we reached Evreux.

Day
4

Evreux to Paris: We cycled through charming villages, stopped for lunch near Septeuil and continued onto Paris. We finished near the Eiffel Tower and celebrated our 71-mile ride with a tasty dinner.

Day
5

Exploring Paris & heading home: We explored Paris in the morning before catching the Eurostar back to London and saying an emotional farewell, with hugs and celebrations.
